Main Idea

The Great King welcomes us through Christ to his table, surrounds us with goodness and faithful love, and gives us a home in his presence forever. We are welcomed not because we are worthy, but because Jesus, the Lamb of God, is worthy.

Discussion Questions

UPWARDS - Growing in Relationship with God

1. In Psalm 23:5–6, what do the table, the overflowing cup, and the house of the Lord reveal about God's care for his people?
2. The sermon reminds us that we are welcomed to God's table not because we are worthy, but because Jesus is worthy. How does this truth shape the way you approach God?
3. David is confident that God's goodness and faithful love will pursue him "all the days" of his life. What can help us trust God's goodness even on difficult days?

INWARDS - Growing in Fellowship with One Another

4. At the Last Supper, Jesus served his disciples with humility. What could it look like for us to serve one another as followers of the Servant King?
5. Christ welcomes people from different nations, cultures, backgrounds, and life stories. How can our small group reflect that same welcome?
6. The sermon gives the challenge, "Do not leave the table of Christ." How can we help one another remain close to Jesus and connected to his church family?

OUTWARDS - Reaching Those Around Us

7. Because Christ has welcomed us with grace, how can we show that same welcome to someone who may feel like an outsider?
8. How can we make it easier for someone new to experience Christian community and discover the grace of Jesus?
9. What one simple action can you take this week to help someone experience Christ's welcome?
