UPWARDS – Growing in Our Relationship with God

- 1. Why do you think God chose to display His power in such visible ways at this stage of redemptive history?
- 2. What does this passage teach us about the relationship between God's power and His purpose to glorify Christ?
- 3. How might reflecting on God's sovereign hand strengthen your trust in His plan for the church today, even when we don't see dramatic miracles?

INWARDS – Growing in Fellowship with One Another

- 4. What would it look like for us to be a community where people can come for encouragement, prayer, and healing?
- 5. How can we reflect the same kind of reverence, authenticity, and fellowship that characterized the early believers?
- 6. How can we encourage one another to depend on the Spirit's power rather than human effort in our service and relationships within the church?

OUTWARDS – Reaching Those Around Us

- 7. Who in your life right now might need to experience God's healing, physically, emotionally, or spiritually? How can you pray or act to bring God's love to them this week?
- 8. How do miracles we find in this passage serve the larger purpose of confirming the gospel message, rather than drawing attention to people?
- 9. How might God be calling us to be instruments of His mercy, to bring the "sick and afflicted" in our communities before Christ in prayer and care?
- 10. How does trusting in God's sovereignty free us from anxiety about "results" when we share our faith or serve others?
