UPWARDS – Growing in Our Relationship with God

1. How does Matthew 6:3-4 challenge or reshape our attitude and motivation when we give?
2. In Haggai 2:8 God says all silver and gold belong to Him. How does this truth reshape the way you view ownership and stewardship?
3. In Exodus 25:1-2, God invites His people to give willingly. How does this challenge or affirm your current understanding of giving?

INWARDS – Growing in Fellowship with One Another

4. How does Acts 20:35 shape the way believers support one another practically, not just spiritually?
5. How do 2 Corinthians 9:7-8 challenge the way we think about motives and attitudes in giving?
6. What does it look like for us to practice contentment (1 Timothy 6:6) in a culture driven by more?

OUTWARDS – Reaching Those Around Us

7. How does 1 John 2:15 challenge us to live counter-culturally in a consumer-driven world?
8. Haggai 2:8 reminds us that everything belongs to God. How does this increase our freedom and confidence to support others?
9. According to 2 Corinthians 9:8, God provides so we can abound in good works. What “good works” might God be inviting us to step into for the sake of others?
