3 Steps to Bible Study



Observation
Looking at Scripture,
taking note of what can
be seen.



Interpretation

Collecting information, and answering questions to determine what a passage means.



What does this passage mean to me? How does it work in my life? How does this change me?

Interpretation

We want to be able to determine the normal, historical accurate, and culturally correct meaning of the text.

Pastonal

Rural rustic themes, heavily descriptive, meditative and quiet, bond between shepherd and sheep.

Poetry

Verses intended to be spoken or sung, sounds of words, symbolism, appeals to the emotions, parallelism.

Prophecy

authoritative presentation of \God's will or message, frequently corrective in nature.

Proverbs

Short pithy statements of moral truths, reduces life to black and white issues, right and wrong.

Satire

Exposes and ridicules human vices and foolishness, warns through negative examples.

Tragedy

Relates the downfall of a person, uses events to relay the path towards ruin.

Wisdom Literature

An older seasoned person relays wisdom to a younger person.
