Battle Ready

Ephesians 6

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. 13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. 14 Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, 15 and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.

<u>Four times in three verses the Bible commands us to stand firm against</u> <u>the enemy</u>

Remember how Paul says in 1 Corinthians 15 that he delivered to the Corinthians the same thing that he had received, this gospel which they have believed, they've received it, now they stand in it. Then he begins to define the gospel in these terms; he says, that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, he was buried, and on the third day he rose, in accordance with the Scriptures. That's the gospel. The gospel is the good news of God's saving work through the death, burial, and resurrection of his Son, Jesus Christ. It's good news of salvation! It's good news for sinners, who will receive it. God is making an offer that he will save all who will trust in his crucified and risen Son.

Colossians 3

<u>15</u>Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. <u>16</u>Let the message of

Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. <u>17</u>And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

When we are followers of Jesus peace should be mark on our life!

If we allow our peace to be based on our situations, we will be very likely to fall.

When our peace is based on what Jesus did for us, we can experience peace in any circumstance because we know God is with us!

Romans 16

Matthew 5

gBlessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.

He intentionally stirs up discord, division, disruption, and disturbance, both within you and around you. *He is the lord of chaos and confusion*, using every opportunity to upset your sense of well-being and stability. He wants you uneasy, unbalanced, filled with anxiety, worry, and

turmoil. Lacking peace! A life without peace is simply unprotected, crippled, unable to move forward, hindered from maturing and developing in a healthy fashion.

In addition to standing our ground, gospel of peace shoes are also for moving. *God expects us to go on the offensive and take the gospel of peace to others.*
