## **Heartfelt Obedience Pt.8**

The context of this is that Jesus is bringing clarity to the Law by exposing the hypocrisy of the religious leaders...

• Matthew 5:20 (NKJV) - "...unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven."

In our text Jesus condemns and rejects this dishonesty... and at the same time...

• ...He instructs His disciples and us He to be truthful with no deceit, and no fingers crossed behind our backs.

Psalm 51:6 (NKJV) - "... You desire truth in the inward parts..."

He's not just talking about the outward action...but the heart

Context for what Jesus is saying here is found in - **Numbers 30:2 (NKJV) -** "If a man makes a vow to the Lord, or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth."

**Matthew 23:16 (NKJV)** - "Woe to you, blind guides, who say, 'Whoever swears by the temple, it is nothing; but whoever swears by the gold of the temple, he is obliged to perform it."

**Psalm 15:4 (NKJV)** makes it clear that if you swear an oath (regardless of what it was based on)...

• ...you we're obligated to keep your word and fulfill it "even when it hurts."

The religious leaders didn't care about this... and exploited this system of oaths to avoid being truthful...

**Matthew 5:37 (NKJV)** – "But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No.' For whatever is more than these is from the evil one."

The Christian's life should reflect a pattern of truth and integrity...

**Philippians 2:14-15 (NLT)** – "Do all things without complaining and disputing, <sup>15</sup> that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God... without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,"
