Heartfelt Obedience Pt.10 Matthew 5:40-42

The context here is that Jesus is bringing clarity to the Law by exposing the hypocrisy of the religious leaders...

Matthew 5:20 - "...unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven."

He said this because outwardly the Scribes and Pharisees looked like they followed God... but their hearts were far from Him.

- Proof of this was that the religious leaders willingly ignored God's bigger picture of love and forgiveness.
 - ...by seeking retribution when wronged by another person

They believed that the right thing to do was to seek revenge and retaliation, this was the only way to deal with an evil person

- but Jesus brings clarity to the Law by emphasizing love instead of revenge.
 - ...He said to the crowd in...

Matthew 5:39 - "But I tell you not to resist an evil person..."

First Example – KEEP AN ETERNAL PERSPECTIVE (v.40)

"It's only candy."

When we live this way... we demonstrate power that makes it possible for God to display His goodness...

…even in the face of people who have evil intentions.

Second Example – GO THE EXTRA MILE – (v.41-42)

Matthew 5:41 - "And whoever compels you to go one mile, go with him two."

Romans 12:20-21 - "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head. ²¹ Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."

How do we apply this tomorrow morning?

John 3:16 - "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."
