## Introduction

"For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope" (Romans 15:4).

## The Seven "A's"

#1: Acceptance – "O Lord, I have heard Your speech and was afraid . . . " (Habakkuk 3:2a).

"God is God and I am not / I can only see a part of the picture He's painting / God is God and I am man / So I'll never understand it all / For only God is God." —Stephen Curtis Chapman

#2: Affirmation - "O Lord, revive Your work in the midst of the years!" (Habakkuk 3:2b).

Omnisapience: God not only knows all things, He always knows what's best!

#3: Awe – "In the midst of the years make it known; In wrath remember mercy" (Habakkuk 3:2c).

**#4: Anticipation** (3:3-15): "You went forth for the salvation of Your people, For salvation with Your Anointed. You struck the head from the house of the wicked . . . " (Habakkuk 3:13).

#5: Amazement – "When I heard, my body trembled; My lips quivered at the voice; Rottenness entered my bones; And I trembled in myself, That I might rest in the day of trouble . . . " (Habakkuk 3:16).

"... the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the poor have the gospel preached to them" (Luke 7:22).

#6: Assurance – "Though the fig tree may not blossom, Nor fruit be on the vines; Though the labor of the olive may fail, And the fields yield no food; Though the flock may be cut off from the fold, And there be no herd in the stalls—Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation" (Habakkuk 3:17-18).

"[T]he just shall live by his faith" (2:20) is repeated in Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11, and Hebrews 10:38!

#7: Adoration – "The Lord God is my strength; He will make my feet like deer's feet, And He will make me walk on my high hills. To the Chief Musician. With my stringed instruments" (Habakkuk 3:19).
