God's consistent response is not based on certainty but on our willingness to be available.

We cannot receive anything new if our hands are already full.

Psalm 24:3-4 (ESV) - “Who shall ascend the hill of the Lord? And who shall stand in his holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to what is false and does not swear deceitfully.”

God often asks us to loosen our grip not because what we're holding is evil—but because it restricts us.

Proverbs 3:4-6 (ESV) - “So you will find favor and good success in the sight of God and man. Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

A church experiences God's most powerful movements when its people prioritize availability over certainty.

Open hands are not the conclusion - they are the starting point.
