Check In #2:

Q: Do my own
responsibilities/leave room to be
interested/concerns/
engaged with the interests of
others? How might I do that?

Q: When God prompts me to action that seems counter to my rights, privileges, prerogatives or station, can I let them go, or do I **cling** to them?

Q: Am I willing to participate with
God in the **changing** of my own
character and nature, so I am more
fully able to join God in His work in
the world?

Q: How would I describe
the character of my
Obedience?
