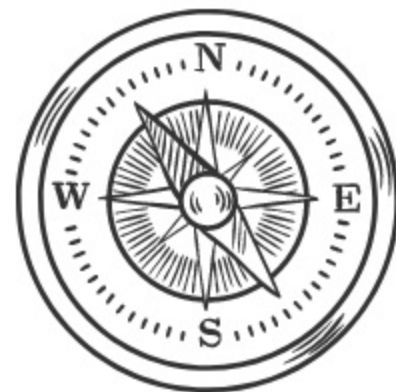
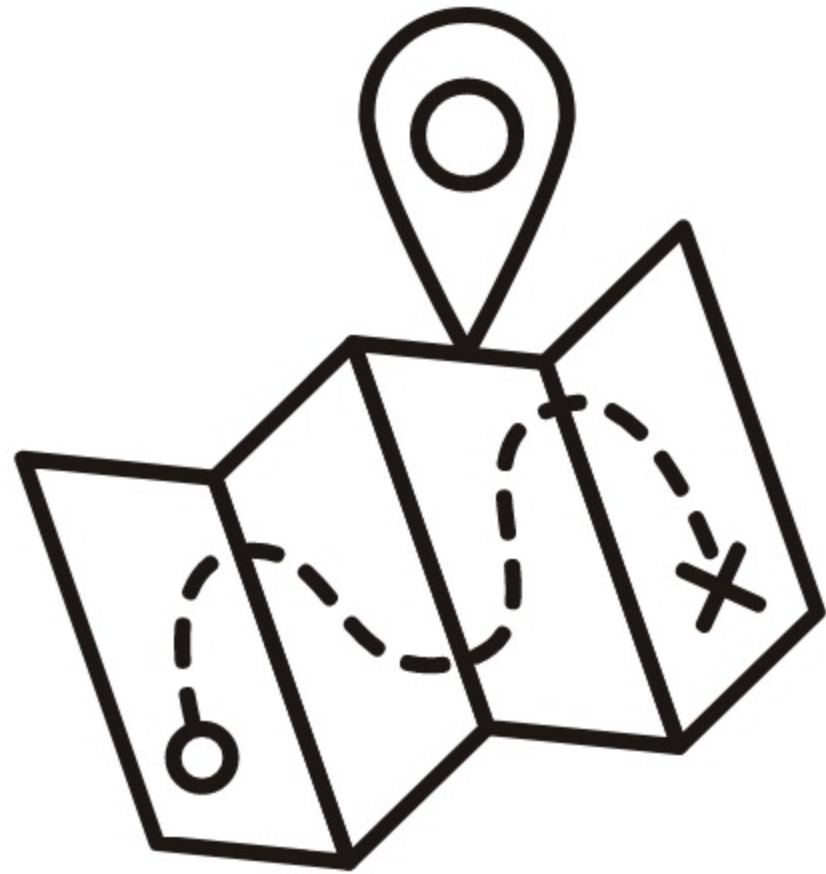


What is the “Sermon on the Mount” in Matthew 5,6,7 other than an invitation from Jesus to change your mind about everything?

- Matt 6:26

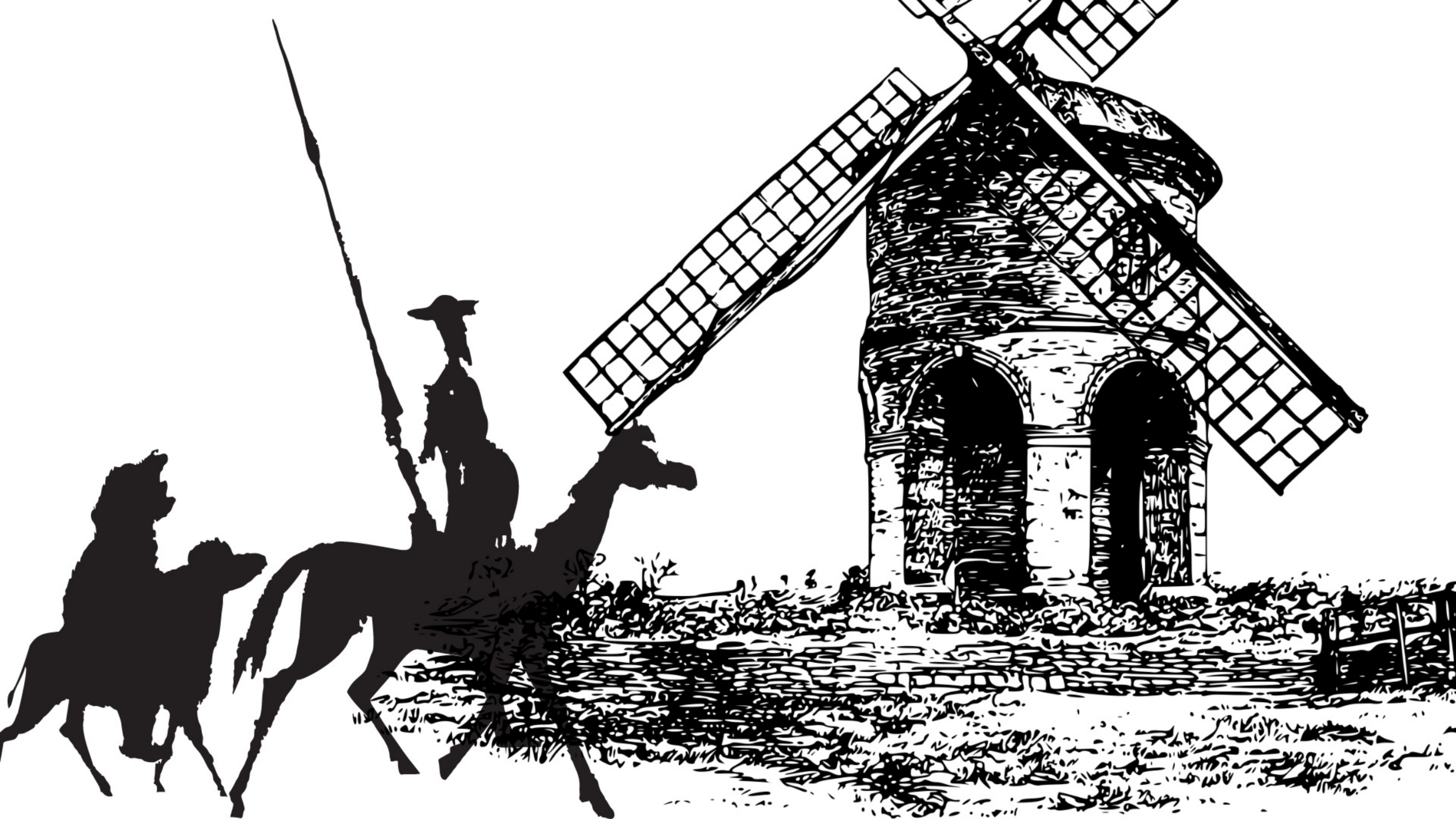
The Good News is “YES!” and “YES!”
