MAGNIFICAT: PAST TENSE

- Vs 49: “he...**has done** great things for me”
- Vs 51: “He **has shown** strength with his arm...he **has scattered** the proud...”
- Vs 52: “He **has brought down** the mighty...and **(has) exalted** those of humble estate
- Vs 53: “He **has filled** the hungry with good things...and the rich he **has sent** away empty”
- Vs 54: “he **has helped** his servant Israel...”



The experience of living with the end in view, the end accomplished, an end-weighted middle is called “HOPE.”



Hope is not a wish, it is a knowing.
