






DO YOU WANT?

everything Jesus says, does, and is has profound consequences for those running and those run by, the system.






Jesus claims a Kingdom "not of this world" but that nevertheless will come to rule every person in this world.








So when the crowd had gathered, Pilate asked them, "Which one do you want me to release to you: Jesus Barabbas, or Jesus who is called the Messiah?"
