Luke 1:1-4

1. Give an example of being told a story that was very hard to believe. Did you double check the information? How much proof do you require before you acknowledge something as truth? Why might this vary?
2. Jesus statement in 19:10 is the key verse for the entire book. Read it, hilite it, return to it often and consider the impact as we proceed through this gospel.
3. Discuss what it might have been like to be Luke and to gather this information from the eyewitnesses.
4. Luke writes this account of Jesus for Theophilus. What does it take to motivate you to share the truth of Jesus in a personal way?
5. Tell the group about who shared the Gospel with you (if someone has) and how they did it? What does that mean to you now?
