

## **Park Hills SBSG Questions**

**Luke 1:5- 25, 57-66, 3:1-22**

1. Describe a time when you could have stood up for God but didn't? OR Describe a time you did what God wanted and people did not like you for it? Why? What happened?
2. Remember how crazy everyone was with the eclipse? How joyful/excited might you/they be after 400 years of silence with God was broken!
3. Read John 3:22-36 together. How does your lifestyle compare or contrast to John's?
4. Read Luke 3:6 - note who this message is for. This is for all people (very inclusive) but hinges upon accepting Christ for who He is and what He says (very exclusive). Are you ready to stand for the truth of God no matter the consequences? How do you think we could help prepare you?
5. John shows great strength and yet great humility. This is like Jesus using 100% truth and 100% love at all times! Which end of the pendulum (strength or humility) do you tend to swing towards? Why is that? What is one way you could start to improve?
6. Does an outsider like John have a better footing to teach and speak like he does? Consider that thought and respond. How might being "too much like everyone else" actually hurt our witness?
