- Women supporting Jesus ministry
- Cost of discipleship – good Samaritan, also 14:25ff & 16:19ff
- The Lord's prayer
- Pharisaical mindset 12:1-3
- The many discussions of money 12:15
- Being anxious
- Coming kingdom – future certainty,
- Prophetic statements of his identity and death, burial, resurrection
- Conflicting worldviews of this world and his kingdom
- Son of Man, Son of God – fully man, fully God
- Pharisee & the sinner 18:9-14
- Betrayal, mock trials, brutality and crucifixion – the way Jesus died
- Glory of the resurrection
