Acts 2:42-47

1. Read Acts 2:40-47 together. How do salvation stories drive us to be excited about Jesus? How does this excitement spur on the church?
2. The believers “had all things in common” and distributed proceeds “as any had need.” What do you love about this statement? What is challenging about it? Would you describe our small group as operating this way? Share stories of times we bore one another’s burdens.
3. Read John 17:20-26. How does our small group fulfill this unity mandate? What are some ways we can improve?
4. Read Galatians 5:22-23. What fruit of the Spirit do you feel God has grown in you the most? What are the fruit that He is currently working on in you?
5. Reread Acts 2:40-47. List all the ways you see the early church living out John 17 and Galatians 5!
6. Some pastors are trying to recreate a “1st century church” – in what ways is this a good thing? In what ways is this impossible?
7. How would a loving community of Christ-followers share faith by just living by these principles?
