Pastoral Panel Demonic Activity & Healing

- 1. "But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere. For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing, to one a fragrance from death to death, to the other a fragrance from life to life." (II Cor. 2:14-16) How often does Christ lead us in triumph? How does this apply to demonic activity?
- 2. Colossians 1:15-20. What is significant about the power Jesus possesses in this passage?
- 3. Luke 8:26-39. How is Christ's power over the spiritual realm evident in this passage? How should that encourage or comfort us?
- 4. Ephesians 6:10-20. How has God given us everything we need for the battle?
- Consider also: Heb. 2:14-16 (destroy the devil); Phil. 2:9-11 (exalted above all names); Heb. 1:2-4. (creator, radiance of God, upholds the universe). It is often best to confront evil with prayer and regular reference to Jesus work on the cross and his authority over all the defeated principalities and powers.
