Luke 13:1-21

1. Read Luke 13:1-21 together (maybe even do one verse per person if comfortable). Why do we try to quantify suffering? Why do we look at some deaths as worse than others or more deserved than others?
2. The truth is that death is coming for us all (unless Christ returns). We cannot escape the fact that we will die. How do you process the statement “he/she is a worse sinner than me” or “he/she is a better person than me, I am a bad sinner?”
3. Review Luke 12:49-59. Compare these verses to Luke 13:6-9 and 13:18-21. What are they missing? What are the signs of today that we miss?
4. Are you in good soil and bearing fruit?
5. Spend some time praying that we would become strong and healthy in our ability to bear fruit and that we would be like the mustard seed – that our faith would start today/tonight and grow into the spiritual life we should have!
