Luke 13:22-14:6

1. Share a time that someone was trying to remind you of a story/event but you couldn't recall it. ---or--- Is there a relationship detail that your significant other recalls differently?
2. Be honest now: when you consider what is saving you, do you look more to the things you do as proof or the One you trust? What are you clinging to in your most difficult times?
3. Read Luke 13:28-30. Consider and interact with this statement, "We may be surprised by who is with us in heaven. We may be even more surprised with who is not there! What do you think about that?"
4. Read John 6:47-51 and Matthew 7:21-23. What do you make of these passages in reference to Luke 13-14? What is the main point Jesus is making in all these passages?
5. For those that think "I will be saved because of how good I am," there is no hope in this statement! How good would be good enough? Who makes the mark to follow? Discuss this and then pray that we 1) wouldn't be those people and 2) will share Jesus faithfully with those that do believe this!
