## SBSG Questions Ephesians 5:20-21

1. Do you have any habits that you currently practice to keep you thankful? What are they? Are they working? What habits would you like to implement to intentionally focus on being thankful?

2. Do you submit to the laws of the land? (taxes, speed limits, seat belts,) Why? If you were given a legitimate "free pass" to never get a speeding ticket how would you drive? What is the contrast between submitting to laws and submitting to Christ?

3. How does being a part of a church family help us understand submission. Read I Peter 5:5-7/Hebrews 13:7,17 What does this teach us about submission?

4. Consider Adam and Eve. Choose between submitting to God (who by the way shows He is "extravagantly permissive" – you have the whole garden just don't eat from this ONE tree. Man was not able to submit his independent/self centered/no body's going to tell me what to do attitude to this one request by God.

5. Close by rereading vs.19 (also Col 3:16). Anyone have a song to sing to group, an instruction/teaching/admonition? Anyone want to lead a song as we close? This is how we are to think of one another and respond to one another.
