

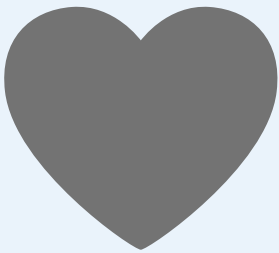
EPC DISCIPLESHIP "HABITS OF GRACE"

Reflection Questions - Session 19

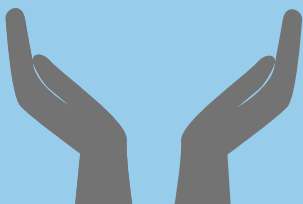
Take some time to pray and reflect over these questions as we move to deepen and grow in walking after Christ.



What does it mean to be “generous” with your finances? This is a difficult question to answer, but just because something is difficult does not mean that it’s not important. Perhaps we can begin by considering how we spend our money and see if we limit our ability to be generous in giving to the church and loving others by the way that we budget money for ourselves.



How can we cultivate and grow in being a “cheerful and joyful” giver (see Ephesians 2:7 & 2 Corinthians 9:15)? To mature in Christ is not an overnight process but something that requires faithful obedience and surrender to Christ over all of our lives. What can we do to practice and grow into this as we live as stewards of God’s blessing and gifting to us in our finances?
