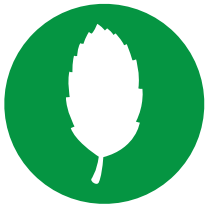

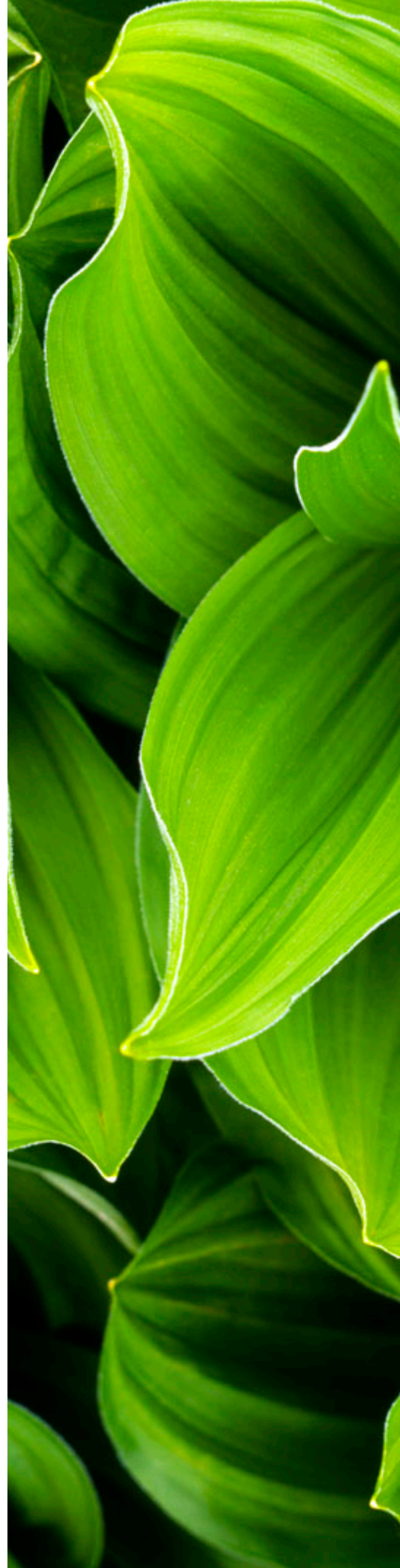

“This is the message we have heard from Him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with Him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

Assurance of Pardon: Romans 8:37-39

“No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

A Gospel Centered Perseverance”

“Walking On Water” Matthew 14:22-33

Reflection Questions:

1. What are some areas of your life where you struggle with keeping your faith and identity in Christ to ground and guide you? How can we confess and turn away from this idolatry in sharing accountability with someone?
2. When the disciples see Jesus walking on water, they are filled with fear as His presence provokes a crisis. But Jesus brings them reassurance and peace in their fear by revealing His identity and love for them. When we experience fear and hardship in life, how can this model for us how we can respond in Jesus’ promise and Word?
3. Where are some places in your life where you think and do things “for” or “about” Christ but are not really grounded in His grace and wisdom first? How can we grow from depending on our own “power” to trusting Him first and living out of Him love?
4. What are some parts of the sermon that stood out to you, convicted you or raised a question? Share them with one another and/or reach out to Pastor Paul and ask as he would love to walk with you in this.
