Romans 12:1-2 | How should we Worship God?

- ❖ Definition: **Worship** is showing ultimate worth of something or someone.
- ❖ **True Biblical Worship** is a response to God's revelation – as we **remember** who He is & what He has done (**Ps. 103:1-2**), **submit** to His will (**Ps.95:6**), **serve** in the power of the Holy Spirit (**Heb. 9:14**), and proclaim to all the supremacy of Christ (**Col. 1:28**), to the glory of God the Father (**Eph. 1:14**).



I. Worship is when you remember God - Romans 12:1

- ❖ What does it mean to remember who God is & what He has done?
- ❖ How do you respond to God's mercy and truth?
- ❖ How does salvation cost you nothing, but at the same time everything?
- ❖ True worship is costly - hence it is sacrificial.

II. Worship is when you submit to God - Romans 12:1-2

- ❖ What does God want from us in our worship of Him?
- ❖ What does it mean to be a living, holy, & acceptable sacrifice?
- ❖ What does it mean to surrender everything to God?

III. Worship is when you serve God - Romans 12:1-13

- ❖ How do we serve and worship God by serving others?
- ❖ What are some ways that we are hindered to be useful to God?
- ❖ How are we able to renew our minds and be transformed?

- ❖ We must aim to worship Christ so as to prize Him above all things.
- ❖ As you examine your life what areas have you've struggled to present yourself to God as a living sacrifice?
- ❖ Has your thinking changed since you've been a Christian? Has your life and behavior changed along with it?
