1 Corinthians 15:14 “And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain”

B. “If We Endure ...” - _____

2 Timothy 2:12a “if we endure, we will also reign with him”

Luke 19:17 “Well done, good servant! Because you have been faithful in a very little, you shall have authority over ten cities.”

Romans 8:18 “For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.”
