#### From Our Corner

May 26, 2025

Several people, who have joined our church family over the past few years, have asked about the church replicas under plexiglass in the Fellowship Hall. Let us once again take a walk down Memory Lane! We are a rural, country community, but our neighbors and church family have many and varied talents which we generously share with each other. Among us are artists, musicians, mechanics, builders, architects, teachers, CPAs, nurses, master gardeners, electricians and plumbers. Most of the time, if any of us have needs, we can pick up the phone and dial a neighbor and advice or help is minutes away. Once in a while, we are "blown away" by an unexpected gift. As Gladys Huey Cox wrote in the church history in 2002, "Of great interest to the members of Unity Church is the preservation of the history of the church and community. Such was the case when Bill Hallman donated the replicas of the first and second church buildings which he had constructed in exact detail, and built to scale, along with complimenting pedestals on which to place them. These replicas were displayed in the parlor of Memorial Hall. Previously, an oil painting of the second church building by Gladys Beasley, and an oil painting of the present church by Libby Thomas were hung in the Memorial Hall Parlor. To complete the paintings of the three churches, Libby graciously consented to paint the first church building, as envisioned by Bill Hallman." After the new Fellowship Hall was completed, Alvin Neill ordered the plexiglass protective covers, and the church replicas were moved to their present day place with the complementary paintings.
