From Our Corner

I have never written about anyone who was not directly connected to our church here at Unity, but today I would like to share memories of a member of our sister church, Shiloh ARP. Phil Robinson was connected to Unity in that he was the Girl Scout dad of Naomi Robinson. Phil Robinson grew up in the Shiloh Church, and was the son of Dan and Koko Robinson. Phil inherited and “fine-tuned” many of his parents’ gifts. Any time Unity members visited Shiloh, we would find his father, Dan playing the organ there. Phil became a gifted musician and was a lead singer with the band while he was at Clemson. He was also a master gardener and landscaper, and a gourmet cook. This love was reflected as he taught his children to love nature, appreciate music and art, and to become responsible and independent teens. Our Girl Scout leaders watched as Naomi moved through our program levels. She arrived at our meetings on time and prepared to present badge work assignments. She was knowledgeable in many areas of the scouting worlds. She had a deep commitment in becoming a good citizen. These attributes were encouraged by the examples set by her parents and grandparents. When we needed help with our GS county cookie pod, Phil was there to direct the placement of the cookies. He made sure the cases were stacked so that our leaders could reach them. He watched for damage boxes and counted the hundreds of crates into inventory. He was present for additional truck deliveries which usually came to a total count of 2400 cases. At the end of that first sale, we were the only service unit with a perfect inventory count! Phil provided this service for several seasons, and he did it with a smile, twinkling eyes and often humming a tune! At the end of each sale, we had accurate counts. Phil died last week at the age of sixty. He is leaving behind children who are well prepared for living happy, productive lives and a heart for service. They will continue to make our world a better place because they have been shown the way by a family who lived and loved with servant hearts. To God be the Glory!
