Week two - “Full of It”

John 1:14 and 8:2-11

Bottom line: A measured response is full of grace *and* truth - we don't get to pick one or the other.

1. Did you have an opportunity this week to offer a measured response instead of a reaction? What happened?
2. How have you experienced the tension between offering someone a grace-filled response and a truth-filled response?
3. Read John 8:2-11
 - a. What stands out to you about this interaction between Jesus and the Pharisees?
 - b. What stands out to you about the interaction between Jesus and the accused woman brought to him?
 - c. How did Jesus demonstrate the fullness of truth and grace?
4. How do we struggle to offer truth and grace at the same time, versus choosing between them?
5. How does truth sound different when it's spoken in love versus not? How does it change our response one way or the other?
6. What examples can you think of in your life or in the world right now where a response that was full of grace *and* truth would make a difference? What would that response specifically look like?
