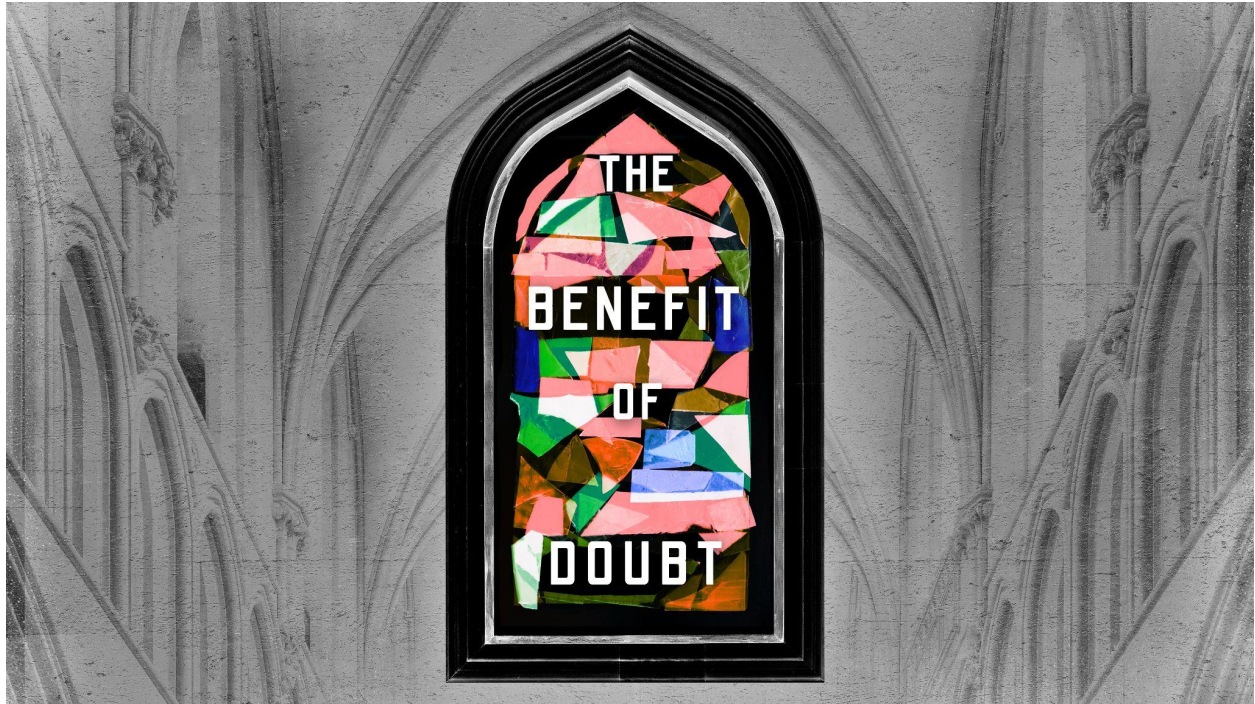




The Benefit of Doubt

Psalm 19:1-10

Bottom line: God reveals Himself to us through *both* nature *and* scripture.

1. Have you ever had your intelligence questioned because of your faith in God? Or, have you ever resisted faith because of your own intelligence?
2. How have you encountered or wrestled with the idea that science and faith are contradictory?
3. How have you experienced science as a companion to your faith?
4. Read Psalm 19:1-10
 - a. What is David trying to capture about the universe and the sun in relation to our understanding of God?
 - b. How does David describe the word of God (precepts, laws, etc.)?
 - c. How does David put the ideas of nature and scripture together - what do they have in common?
5. How can questions and obstacles to our faith become opportunities to grow our faith instead of giving up on God? How can we apply the scientific method to our faith?
6. What are some of the ways the observable world increases your own awe and wonder of God?
