1. What do you think it means to honor God?
2. What does it look like to dishonor God?
3. How did Eric Liddell honor God both by running and by not running? Do his decisions make sense to you, or not? What would happen if someone did that today?
4. Why is it so difficult to wait on God when we don't have all the answers?
5. How can you do the right thing even while waiting for more information?
6. Charles Stanley famously said that our job is to obey God and leave the outcome up to Him. What might it look like in your life to do that? How does it change the way you process decisions to be obedient with what you know and trust God with the results?
