4. Read John 13:34-35. How is the platinum rule different from the golden rule?
5. What makes the platinum rule so difficult to follow?
6. “According to Paul, the primary duty of church folks is to one-another one another.” (*Irresistible*, page 215). His list includes submit to one another, forgive one another, encourage one another, restore one another, accept one another, care for one another, bear with one another, and carry one another’s burdens. How are we doing?
7. How would people you know feel differently about the church if we got better at the one-another ethic?
8. How does the question, “What does love require of me?” change how you operate? How could it change your marriage? Your parenting? Your work environment?
9. What is one thing you can do this week to one-another better? How can this group pray for you?
