Bottom line: The good news is meant to be shared and embodied.

- 1. Why do you think so many people are following Jesus almost 2,000 years after his life on earth?
- 2. What might make it easier for people to follow Jesus now? What might make it more difficult for people to follow Jesus now?
- 3. How does Jesus remain the central figure in the story even after he ascends to heaven?
- 4. Read John 14:12-27
  - a. How does Jesus describe the Holy Spirit?
  - b. How is the Holy Spirit supposed to help us continue Jesus' work?
  - c. How does Jesus going to the Father (verse 12) make it possible for us to do even greater things?
- 5. What does it mean to call followers of Jesus "the body of Christ?"
- 6. How are we sharing the good news about Jesus with others?
- 7. What keeps us from sharing the good news about Jesus with others?
- 8. Read Acts 1:8. Do people know more about God because of your life and how you live? How are you living as a witness to Jesus?
