Acts 1:1-11 and John 14

Bottom line: The good news is meant to be shared and embodied.

1. Why do you think so many people are following Jesus almost 2,000 years after his life on earth?
2. What might make it easier for people to follow Jesus now? What might make it more difficult for people to follow Jesus now?
3. How does Jesus remain the central figure in the story even after he ascends to heaven?
4. Read John 14:12-27
 - a. How does Jesus describe the Holy Spirit?
 - b. How is the Holy Spirit supposed to help us continue Jesus' work?
 - c. How does Jesus going to the Father (verse 12) make it possible for us to do even greater things?
5. What does it mean to call followers of Jesus "the body of Christ?"
6. How are we sharing the good news about Jesus with others?
7. What keeps us from sharing the good news about Jesus with others?
8. Read Acts 1:8. Do people know more about God because of your life and how you live? How are you living as a witness to Jesus?
