Week one - "The Gift of Anticipation"

James 1:17-18, Psalm 130, and Luke 2:22-38

Bottom line: Holy anticipation is the expectation that God is up to something good, coupled with the excitement and mystery of just how and just when that goodness will come.

- 1. What is the best gift you've ever received?
- 2. Do you know someone you would consider a good gift giver? What makes them so good?
- 3. How is anticipation different from just waiting for something to happen?
- 4. Read Luke 2:22-38
  - a. Why do you think Simeon and Anna waited so long?
  - b. What do you think they thought they would see?
  - c. How were their reactions to Mary and Joseph and Jesus different because they waited?
- 5. How is our waiting different when we expect God will do something, even if we don't know when or how?
- 6. How can you receive the gift of anticipation this Christmas?
