Week three - "Moving Help"

Joshua 1:12-18

Bottom line: You are the help someone needs.

- 1. Who helped you move the last time you switched residences? What's your best story from a move either helping someone else move (between houses, apartments, etc.) or a time you moved? At what age can you no longer ask your friends to help you move in exchange for pizza (and why is the answer 25)?
- 2. Read Joshua 1:12-18
 - a. Why do you think the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half-tribe of Manasseh were content to stay on the east side of the Jordan River, not moving into the Promised Land?
 - b. Do you think they regretted telling Moses they would help the other tribes move? Why do you think they did it anyway?
- 3. Have you ever been asked for any kind of help, or seen someone in need of help, and said no? Why did you say no?
- 4. What are some good reasons not to help (this is not a trick question)?
- 5. What are some terrible reasons not to help?
- 6. How have you been assuming you can't help someone when maybe you actually can?
- 7. Read John 14:15-17. Why is it significant that Jesus gave us the Holy Spirit to help us? How does the Holy Spirit help you help someone else?
- 8. How could you help someone this week?
