



A Jesus Worth Following

Scripture Reference: Matthew 9:9-12, John 20:14-16, 1 John 2:3-6, Matthew 12:7

1. What is your favorite story about Jesus that is from the Bible?
2. Read Matthew 9:9-13. What part sticks out to you most in these verses?
3. In what ways do you find it hard to follow Jesus?
4. In what ways do you find it comforting to follow Jesus?
5. In the message this week there was a challenge to “live a life worth questioning” by letting ourselves be spiritually formed by the “dangerous stories” that our great hero (Jesus) leads us to live. What is your “dangerous story” in following Jesus, or what “dangerous story” do you feel led to live?
6. The message concluded with the idea that Jesus came for and protects the broken. How does this truth encourage you to continue to follow Jesus?
7. Conclude by reading Psalm 34:17-19 MSG: ¹⁷ Is anyone crying for help? God is listening, ready to rescue you. ¹⁸ If your heart is broken, you’ll find God right there; if you’re kicked in the gut, he’ll help you catch your breath. ¹⁹ Disciples so often get into trouble; still, God is there every time.
