Week four - "This is New"

John 1:1-14 and 14:5-11, and Matthew 5:17-48

Bottom line: To know Jesus is to know God - this is new and this is good news!

- 1. How would you describe the difference between the Old Testament and the New Testament?
- 2. How does it seem like God is different between the Old Testament and the New Testament?
- 3. Read John 1:1-14
 - a. Why do you think John starts his account of Jesus' life with the words, "In the beginning..."?
 - b. What do you think it means that "the Word was with God and the Word was God?"
 - c. What was the difference between John the Baptist's role and Jesus' role? (vv 6-9)
 - d. Why is it such a big deal that God came to dwell among us?
- 4. Jesus taught with authority and so much of what he said felt new and different to the people who were listening. Look at Matthew 5:17-48. How does Jesus connect what he is teaching to what they have heard before?
- 5. Why do you think some of the people were hesitant to believe Jesus was actually God? What makes it hard for us to believe Jesus is God?
- 6. Read John 14:5-11. What does knowing Jesus tell us about God? Said differently, how do we understand God differently because of everything Jesus said and Jesus did?
- 7. Are there specific things about God that Jesus makes more apparent or understandable?
- 8. How does Jesus change your desire or ability to believe in God?
