

90 - Life of Jesus Week Six - "Wreck it, Jesus" John 2:13-22 (also Matthew 21:12-17, Mark 11:15-19, Luke 19:45-48) Bottom line: Jesus didn't come to fix the old system, but to establish a new reality.

- 1. What things are on your "fix it" list? For your own life? For the world in general?
- 2. Can you think of an example of something that had to be wrecked before it could be truly fixed or made better?
- 3. Read John 2:13-22, Matthew 21:12-17, Mark 11:15-19, and Luke 19:45-48
  - a. These accounts are often referred to as Jesus "cleaning" the Temple. What stands out to you in these passages?
  - b. Why do you think it matters that Jesus cleared everything out?
  - c. Who would have experienced the greatest disruption from this event?
  - d. How was Jesus changing their entire system of receiving forgiveness?
- 4. How is Jesus' offer of "new" better than an invitation to "improve?"
- 5. What parts of your life is Jesus more likely to disrupt than fix?
