Week one - "Give Me a Sign"

John 1:1-14 and 14:19-21

Bottom line: If you want to hear from God, start with Jesus.

1. When you find yourself asking God for a sign, what are you usually hoping He will clarify or decide for you?
2. Why do you think clear signs do not always lead people to trust or obey God? Where do you see that tension in your own life?
3. John calls Jesus "the Word," "the true light," and God made flesh. Which of those descriptions stands out most to you, and why?
4. What might it practically look like to "start with Jesus" when you are seeking God's direction about a decision?
5. Which practice would most help you grow in relationship with Jesus right now: making time with Him, reading about Him, learning with other believers, or inviting Him into everyday questions? Why?
6. As we explore Scripture, the Holy Spirit, wise counsel, reason, and circumstances in the coming weeks, which one do you tend to rely on most—and which one might you overlook?
