Week two - "Greater Expectations"

Isaiah 2:1-5, Revelation 21:1-7, and Luke 17:20-21

Bottom line: Our great expectations need to be even greater expectations, and participation.

- 1. What expectations do you have for this Christmas?
- 2. What are some expectations you may have that you didn't realize you were bringing into this season?
- 3. When you hear that Jesus is coming again, what do you think that means? What does it make you think about? What questions do you have about that?
- 4. Read Luke 17:20-21
 - a. What question did the Pharisees **ask** about the kingdom of heaven?
 - b. What question did Jesus answer about the kingdom of heaven?
 - c. What did Jesus mean when He said the kingdom of heaven is within our grasp?
- 5. In what ways do you see your life now as part of the kingdom of God? In what ways does it feel disconnected from, or *in waiting for*, the kingdom of God?
- 6. How can we prepare for Jesus now in a way that expects God to re-order some of our circumstances and priorities?
- 7. What would it look like for you to have **greater expectations** in light of what Jesus already did, and also what He says He will do when He returns?
- 8. How do our greater expectations change the ways we live and the ways we give?
