### Week three - "The B-I-B-L-E"

**1 Corinthians 15:1-8, 14; 2 Timothy 3:10-17**

**Bottom line: The Bible is essential to our faith because Jesus is the foundation of our faith.**

2. Has your view of the Bible evolved over time? How? Why?
3. Discuss how these two statements landed with you: The Bible is essential to our Christian faith *and* the validity of Christianity does not depend on the viability and plausibility of a Bible without error.
4. What's the difference between believing the Bible is without error and believing the validity of Christianity depends on that being true? Why do you think this matters for some people? Why does it matter to you?
5. How does your faith in Jesus now make you consider the Bible differently than you have in the past?
6. How do you engage with scripture in your life? Are there things that make it difficult for you?
