Week five - "God at Work"

John 14:5-11 and 15:1-13

Bottom line: Jesus is the illustration and demonstration of who God is and how God works.

1. What is one of the first things you were taught about God? Is it something that continues to inform your faith?
2. What is the most difficult thing to believe about God that you were told is **essential** to believe as a Christian?
3. Read John 14:5-11
 - a. How do you relate to Thomas and Philip and the questions they are asking Jesus as they try to understand what He is saying?
 - b. How does Jesus become our best opportunity to know God, see God, and believe God?
4. Is there anything about Jesus that conflicts with the view of God you grew up with? If so, what?
5. Ultimately, our faith comes down to believing Jesus that he is who he says he is. How does that belief change your understanding and willingness to follow Him, even and especially when it's uncomfortable or uncertain?
6. In what ways are you more willing to believe *in* God than you are to believe God?
