

learning about him and youth ministry, which is the elective I chose to train in. After the training I will be doing 2 months of outreach. During this time I will be working hands-on in youth ministry leading youth camps, running youth events, and mentoring the young people of Australia."

Claire Neuman writes, "This July I am going to be embarking on the adventure of a lifetime. I will be attending a Discipleship Training School through YWAM (Youth With A Mission) in Toowoomba, Australia with a focus on Worship and Ministry Training. Three months of the five months will be classroom training at the base in Toowoomba, and then the next two months will be outreach in a Southeast Asian country. During the classroom training we will be focusing on studying our identity in Christ as believers and learning how Christ sees us. We will also be learning how to teach the gospel in many different settings and situations. In order to practice what we learn, when we are not in class we will be ministering with music and sharing the gospel at local coffee shops, children centers and at other places throughout the community. I am not completely sure what to expect during the outreach phase of the DTS, I don't even know what country I will be in. But I do know that God will be moving and I know that it will be a life changing experience for me and I am extremely excited for what God has in store for me! Thank you all so much for your support and prayers."

Leah Germain writes, "I will be joining a team called Trek7 put together by Reach Global. The trip runs from June 20th -August 5th. Trek7 has a threefold focus: deepening your walk with Christ, growing your appreciation for the culture, and expanding your ministry experience. I will have the opportunity to teach English with Costa Ricans, serve children in poverty by making crafts, teaching Bible lessons, serving lunch, etc., organize outreach events, plan and lead summer activities for missionary kids, and help a local ministry to prostituted women and transvestites. Specifically things that you could be praying for would be that I would return home with a better grasp of the Spanish language- as fluency is what I am working towards- and that no fear would hinder me from serving Jesus with Trek7.
