
Today's Passage

The True Son

John 8:12 – Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

I was at a seminar awhile back and one of the keynote speakers was Jerry Linenger. Jerry is an astronaut that spent five months on the Mir Space Station. It was a very fascinating talk. He went through the launching of the space shuttle, the weightlessness of space, and all the other things that come to mind when you think about an astronaut.

Several times on the space station Jerry almost lost his life. The Mir Space Station was a piece of equipment that was past its life expectancy and there were major alarms daily and a lot of them were serious in nature. One of the alarms that was life threatening was when they lost control of the solar panels and could not line them up to the sun to charge their batteries. Without that power, the systems would shut down including the oxygen system. They shutdown all unnecessary equipment and entered the dark side of the earth. Jerry mentioned he had never experienced that kind of darkness in his life.

While he was going into detail about what their plan was going to be when they got to the light side of the earth, I kept thinking how it is like us and God. When I lose my sight of the true Son, that feeling is dark and crushing. Not until I realign myself with God, do my batteries get recharged. Just as when Jerry went around to the dark side of the earth he knew that the sun would be coming up. I know that if I lose sight of God I can find Him right were he has always been, I just need to make that move. It is a great feeling to know I can leave the dark and enter the light.

As you may have guessed since Jerry was talking to us, they were able to get the solar panels realigned and charge the batteries. I ask you today to get realigned with God to charge your batteries.
