
Today's Passage

pastoral ponderings

Looking to Jesus. What an interesting way to start a verse. The other day I was thinking on all the great passages that I could muse about here and I asked my wife. Without hesitation she said Hebrews 12:2. As I read it I had to think to myself "what an interesting place to start a verse". This verse is in the middle of something. It doesn't even start with a capital, just "looking to Jesus...". With a versus like this, my nature will not let me just go on from there, I have to look around. I can't just start in the middle of a sentence I want to know the full context. So, Hebrews twelve one says "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us...". Well that helps! Therefore! You can't start a thought with therefore. So now I have to go back to Hebrews eleven. The writer has just finished telling us that Faith is the promise that we will receive the things we long for, "the assurance of things hoped for". Through faith we can be confident of things we have been told but cannot see. He goes on to show us the long list of those who acted out of this very concept. Those whose lives gave evidence to this very belief. Even though they could not see the result, they believed. Each of them acting strangely for this world because they had faith in a promise. Picking up and moving, having a baby at 90, giving up your son to the river in a basket, marching around a city as an act of war. None of these make sense until you see the results. But they were obedient. They followed what they "hoped for" when it did not make sense in this world. Looking back now we can say that what they did made sense based on what happened afterwards. But they didn't get to see that they just acted out of what they hoped for, knowing that God would provide what they longed for. And all of them, even though they made for great witnesses to faith, did not receive that which was promised. God had provided in them something better for us, that they would be made perfect together with us. That is amazing! That all these great men and women who did amazing, impossible things, far beyond what I could ever hope to do, are right there waiting on us to receive together with us the promise that is for us all.

"Therefore". Suddenly therefore carries a whole lot more weight. As they continue in faith to wait for the promise that we will receive together, let us have no excuse to not follow their example. Let us not get caught up in excuses and the things of this world but follow their example throwing off this world because we know we will inherit so much more. Just as they knew and their lives stand witness to it. But wait, I don't have an Ark to build or a Red Sea to cross. I probably won't suffer "mocking and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment". So how am I in the same boat as these great witnesses? Why do we all get

They look forward in time, we look backward in time, both looking to Jesus. And though I do not know what trials or discipline I may endure, I know that the same Author who brought them through it will bring me through and has brought me together with all those others and has **perfected** our faith.

As I wait for Sunday, I get encouragement from these men and women, but I **look** to Jesus who endured the shame of the cross so that He would secure the joy set before Him. The joy of perfecting our faith and reuniting us with a Great and Awesome God. It Is Finished!
