## Ministry Highlight

The days are getting longer though for now it seems imperceptible. By January's end, it will be quite obvious. And we welcome the light because light is good! Humans are naturally drawn to light whether the light of a new day, fireworks, Christmas lights, even a glowing candle or bonfire. In the Bible, "light" is spoken of often, representing many wonderful things such as God's holiness, His presence, spiritual truth, knowledge and understanding, purity, guidance, and more. Light illuminates the darkness and helps us see the path ahead. The Word of God is meant to do that ... "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path" (Psalm 119:105). We rely on the Spirit of God within us to reveal God's truth and give us deeper understanding - light! On our own, we can't understand anything of any eternal value and live in darkness.

This is why I love to read other Christian books that the Holy Spirit can also use to help me see God in truer, real-life ways. Mr. Eco viewed his books in terms of the possibilities that exist within them, the things he didn't know and had yet to learn. God knows what I need to learn and when I need to learn that lesson. I can trust Him with the unread books on my shelves.

New Life has a wonderful Resource Center, filled with books of all kinds (and some musical CD's) to help you to know and connect with God in new and deeper ways. We have books for children of all ages, women, those interested in church history, missions, Bible study, spiritual disciplines, fiction, young people, biographies, and many more topics. All resources are available for purchase; we are not a lending library despite the name "resource center." We can also special order books such as Bible study guides, large print Bibles, etc. if you have such a need. Books also make great gifts! We'd love to help you find a book to meet your interests, or feel free to come peruse the shelves yourself. There is a volunteer on duty every Sunday before and after the service. Besides reading and musical resources, we also sell homemade cards made by our own Barb Manship. The proceeds from card sales

**Ministry Team Fair:** Sunday January 25<sup>th</sup>


