# Pastoral Pondering

# **Thanksgiving**

As an American, when I think of Thanksgiving, my thoughts immediately go to football, turkey dinner with pumpkin pie, and wonderful family time. As a Scandinavian, we always had lefsa and herring, I'm getting hungry just writing this.

Let's learn about the history of the first Thanksgiving. The original thanksgiving celebration was held by the Pilgrim settlers in Massachusetts during their second winter in America in December 1621. The first winter had killed many of them, 44 died out of the 102 colonists. At one point their daily food ration was down to five kernels of corn apiece, but then an unexpected trading vessel arrived, swapping them beaver pelts for grain, providing for their severe needs. The next summer's crop brought hope, and Governor William Bradford decreed that December 13, 1621, be set aside as a day of feasting and prayer to show the gratitude of the colonists that they were still alive.

Along with the feasting and games involving the colonists and more than 80 Native Americans who added to the feast by bringing wild turkeys and venison, <u>prayers</u>, <u>sermons</u>, <u>and songs of praise were important in the celebration</u>. Three days were spent feasting and praying.

Scripturally, we find things related to the issue of thanksgiving throughout the Bible. Individuals offered up sacrifices out of gratitude in the book of Genesis. The Israelites sang a song of thanksgiving as they were delivered from Pharaoh's army after the crossing of the Red Sea. The book of Psalms is packed full of songs of thanksgiving, both for God's grace to the Israelite people through His mighty deeds, as well as for His individual graces to each of us.

In the New Testament, there are repeated admonitions to give thanks to God. <u>Thanksgiving is to always be a part of our prayers</u>. Some of the most remembered passages on the giving of thanks are the following:

- \* "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18).
- \* "do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God." (Philippians 4:6).
- "First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people," (1 Timothy 2:1).

Of all of God's gifts, the greatest one He has given is the gift of His Son, Jesus Christ. On the cross of Calvary, Jesus paid our sin debt, so a holy and just judge could forgive us of our sins and give us eternal life as a free gift. This gift is available to those who will call on Christ to save them from their sin in simple but sincere faith (John 3:16; Romans 3:19-26; Romans 6:23; Romans 10:13; Ephesians 2:8-9). For this gift of His Son, the gift which meets our greatest need, the apostle Paul says, "Thanks be to God for his inexpressible gift!" (2 Corinthians 9:15).


