CONFESSION OF SIN

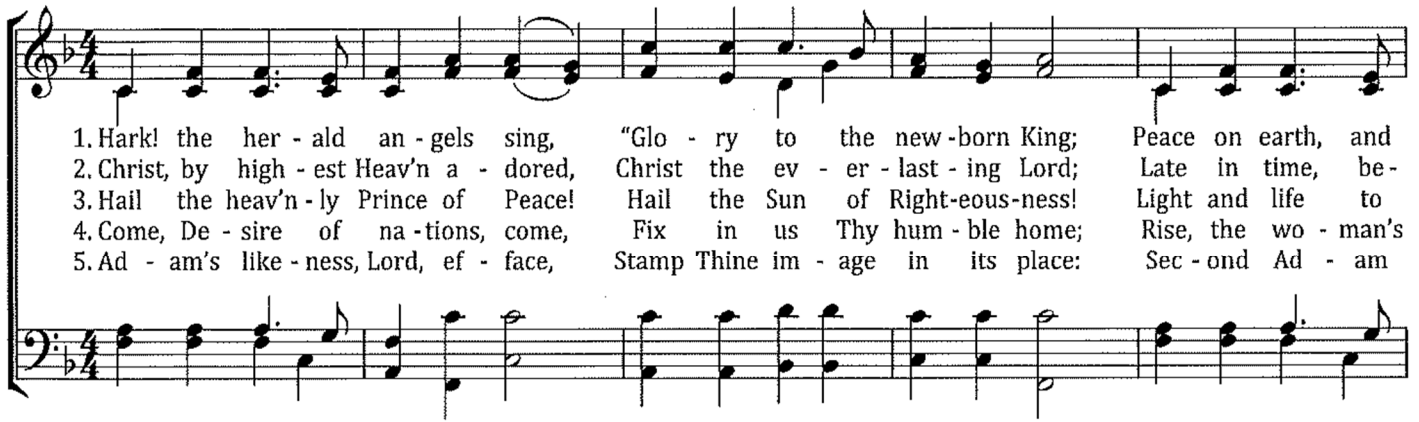

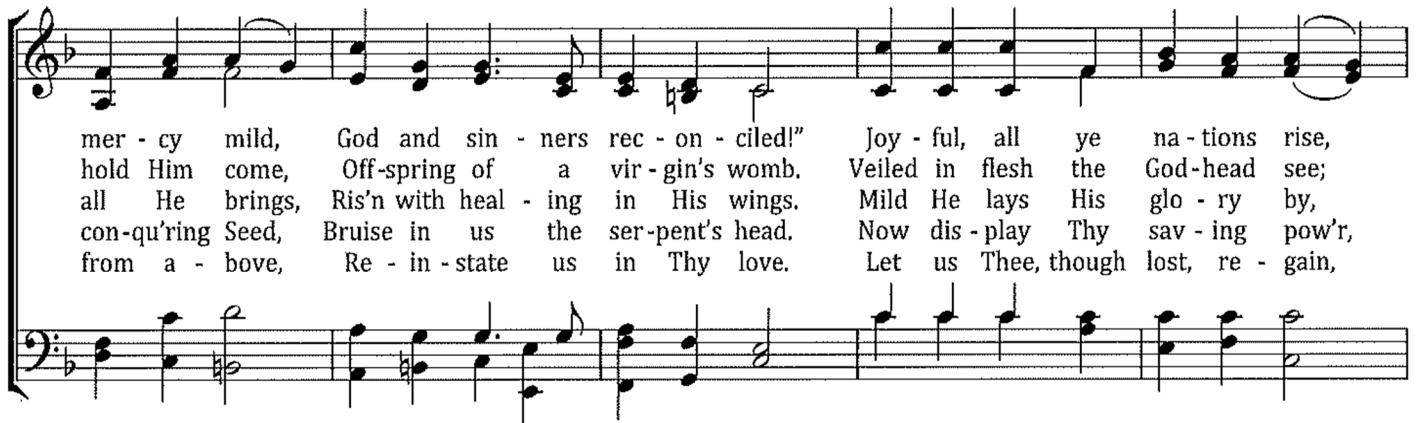

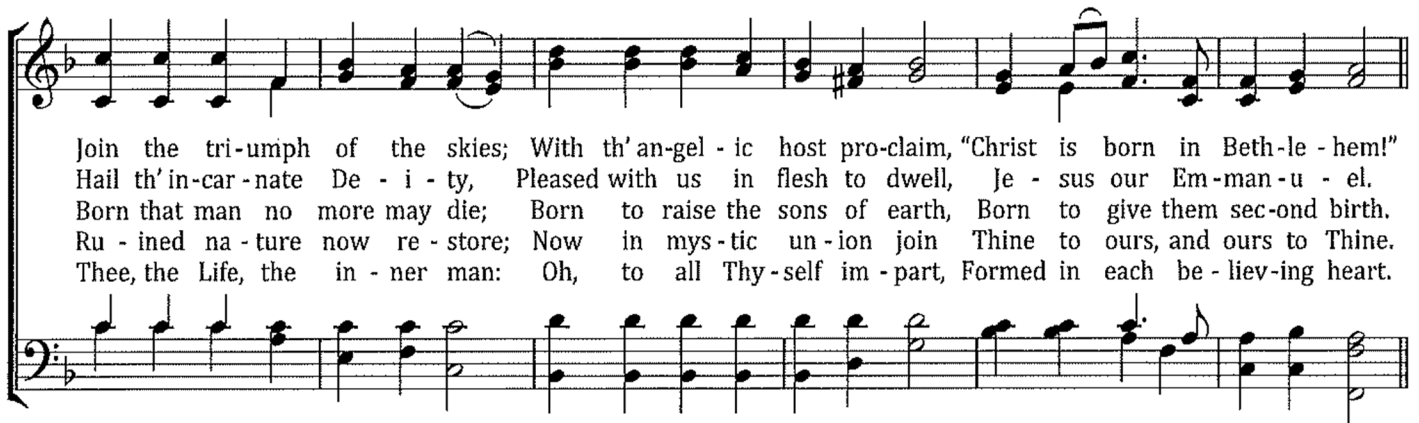
