Hebrews 13:1-6 Overview

- 1. Ongoing self-giving/sacrificial love for the Christians we know vs. 1
- 2. Occasional self-giving/sacrificial love for Christians we don't know vs. 2
- 3. Empathetic self-giving/sacrificial love for Christians who are suffering (particularly to those who are suffering because of their stand for Jesus)

Which will require:

- 1. Marriages being honored and protected as an ongoing display of vs. 4 the self-giving/sacrificial love that Jesus has for the church vs. 5-6
- 2. That we not put our trust in money for our security, but instead continue to trust in Jesus' ongoing, self-giving love for us.
