Basic Christianity 2 – 1 "Repentance from dead works"

Main text: Hebrews 5:11-6:3 (KJV)

Maturity: God's will and purpose for us all

Defined in terms of understanding; discernment of good and evil and proper application. (learning to living)

- I. Repentance from dead works
 - A. Repent: to change one's mind

To change directions
To reverse course

- 1. Two kinds of repentance
 - a. Unbelievers= for salvation (original sin)

Romans 3:23 (all have sinned...)

Romans 6:23 (wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus)

Romans 5:17-19 Adam's sin; Jesus' obedience (Psalms 51:5 – Behold I was shaped in iniquity and in sin did my mother conceive me)

- b. Believers- A new lifestyle (personal sins)

 Constant changing as we behold Gods glory
- - 2. Dead works (2 kinds as well)
 - a. sins Hebrews 9:14 (ref) Colossians 1:21(ref)

b. self-righteousness (our good works)

Ephesians 2:8 (KJV)

Titus 3:5 (KJV)

The works themselves are not evil but the <u>motives</u> are. It causes us to trust or put faith in ourselves vs. God. It causes us to try to earn or deserve things from God.

- B. Repentance Preached
 - 1. John the Baptist (Matthew 3:2)
 - 2. Jesus (Mark 1:15/Matthew 4:17)
 - 3. Disciples (Mark 6:12)
 - 4. Peter (Acts 2:38/Acts 3:19)
 - 5. Paul (Acts 17:30/Acts 26:20)

- C. Gospel Message (3 elements)
 - 1. An announcement good news (Jesus saves)

Romans 2:4 – <u>Leads</u> men to repentance

2. A Command – repent (You need saved) Acts 17:20

2 Corinthians 7:10 Godly sorrow works repentance

3. A Call - Believe (Receive God's gift)

Mark 16... whosoever believes

John 5:24... believe on him

Good news/repent/believe

- II. Why we repent as believers?
 - 1. Not to be saved! Born-again...again
 - 2. Not to get God to love or accept us (He never stopped)
 - 3. Because we have a new nature and want to do what's right
 - 4. We have God's wisdom and see the wages of sin (Romans 6:23)

Sin (even forgiven by God is dangerous)
Sin grieves God vs. angers him (Hebrews 12 chastening)
Sin harms us and others

- 4 Categories in regard to wisdom over sin
 - 1. Sin brings bondage and enslaves us John 8:34 (KJV)
 - 2. Sin gives Satan place in our lives.

(John 10:10) ref.

Romans 6:16 (KJV)

3. Sin hardens our hearts

Hebrews 3:7-19 (KJV)

4. Sin defiles our conscience.

Hebrews 9:14 (KJV) Romans 2:12-15 (KJV) 1 John 3:19-21 (KJV) 1 John 1:7-9 (KJV)
